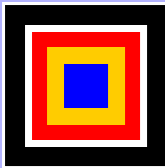

Rangoli Competition on the theme of “International Women’s Day Celebration”

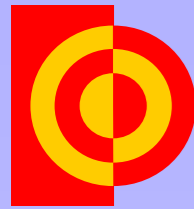
Department had organized Rangoli Competition to motivate students to showcase their creativity and innovative ideas.

Women Empowerment- Celebrating Women Entrepreneurship

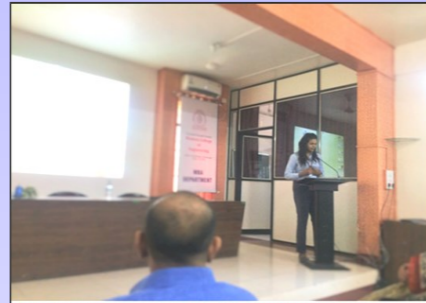
