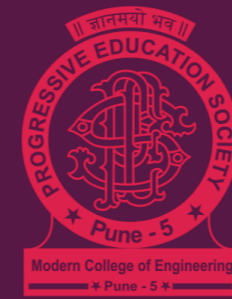

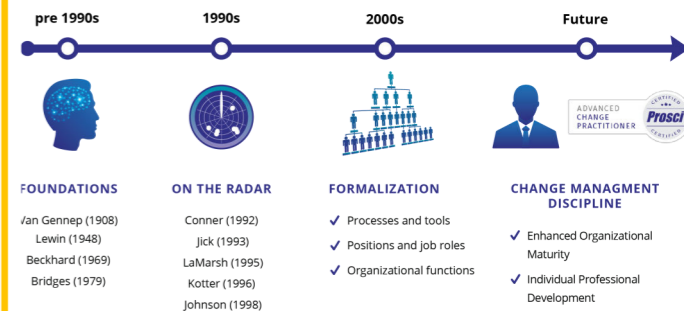

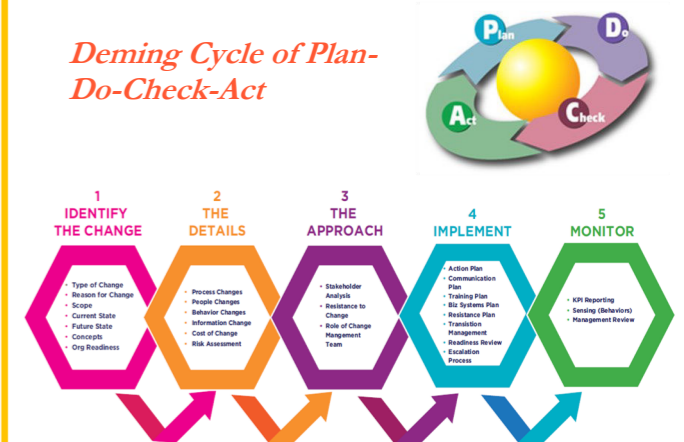
CHANGE MANAGEMENT TIMELINE

Summer Lunch Salad

INGREDIENTS:
Iceberg Lettuce: 2 bowls, finely chopped
Onions: 1/2 bowl, finely chopped
Cherry tomatoes: 1/2 bowl, diced
Zucchini: 1/2 bowl, diced
Fresh corn: 1/2 bowl, boiled (if using)
South Western salad dressing: 1 teaspoon
Salt, olive oil, any other salad dressing of your choice

PROCEDURE:

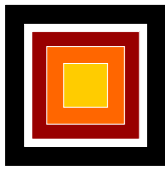
- Add chopped onions to a big bowl. Add cherry tomatoes.
- Season it with a spoon of olive oil, salt and pepper (add a pinch of sugar if you like). Mix and let it stay for five minutes.
- Add the boiled corn and zucchini to the bowl. Add the sweet onion and south western salad dressings.
- Mix well and add the iceberg lettuce. Serve fresh. Salads are a great way to keep fit, stay healthy, and this one is particularly filling. The olive oil gives you natural essential fats, and you can add cucumber on top for a summery touch. And all of this, at just Rs 180.
